LEGAL STRUCTURE



Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission Act 2012 Association Incorporation legislation requirements;

- 1. Have a committee that manages the association
- 2. Have a minimum of 5 members.
- 3. Having a public officer
- 4. Having a registered office in its state of incorporation
- 5. Acting under all the rules of legislation
- 6. Holding an annual general meeting once a year
- 7. Lodging an annual statement every year
- 8. Keeping proper accounting records
- 9. Keeping minutes of all committee and general meetings
- 10. Having registers of members and all committee members
- 11. Having a common seal.

From 1 July 2019, incorporated associations that are significantly or principally engaged in trading or financial activities will have to comply with the corporate whistleblower protection regime in Part 9.4AAA of the Corporations Act 2001.
